Conditions for Non-Routine Visits

- The school will provide information about the visit, so that parents and guardians can understand the level of supervision to be provided, before giving consent for their child to take part in the visit and activities described.
- All reasonable care will be taken of pupils during the visit/activity and all pupils will be under an obligation to obey all directions and instructions given and observe all rules and regulations governing the visit/activity.
- If a child seriously misbehaves or is a cause of danger to him/herself or to others, then parents/guardians may be asked to collect him/her or he/she may be brought home early from the visit/activity. In such a situation there will be no obligation on the school/establishment to refund any money.
- In an emergency, where a pupil requires medication or any emergency dental, medical or surgical treatment, including anaesthetic or blood transfusion, as considered necessary by the medical authorities present, school staff will refer to the consent provided in the Pupil Admission Form held at the school.
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform school staff of any medical conditions, allergies, contact with contagious or infectious diseases or changes to any other personal or medical information contained on the pupil admission form that staff need to be aware of prior to the school trip.
- School/establishment staff may use activity images in line with consent provided on the photo consent section of the pupil admission form.
- All young people are covered by the Local Authority's third party public liability insurance in respect of any claim arising from an accident caused by a defect in the school/establishment premises or equipment or attributable to negligence by the Council or one of its employees. Please note that this insurance policy does not include personal accident or personal belongings cover for your child.
